How Can I Go Wide as An Eternal Change Agent for God?

- 1. By accepting that I have been strategically placed where I am by God.**
 - **Luke 19:1:** *“Jesus entered Jericho and was passing through.”*
- 2. By looking for people who are looking for a supernatural intervention into their lives.**
 - **Luke 19:2-4:** *“A man was there by the name of Zacchaeus; he was a chief tax collector and was wealthy. ³He wanted to see who Jesus was, but being a short man he could not, because of the crowd. ⁴So he ran ahead and climbed a sycamore-fig tree to see him, since Jesus was coming that way.”*
- 3. By speaking into the lives of people far from God.**
 - **Luke 19:5-7:** *“When Jesus reached the spot, he looked up and said to him, ‘Zacchaeus, come down immediately. I must stay at your house today.’ ⁶So he came down at once and welcomed him gladly. ⁷All the people saw this and began to mutter, ‘He has gone to be the guest of a ‘sinner.’”*
- 4. By being exhilarated when God uses mundane me to accomplish the miraculous.**
 - **Luke 19:8-10:** *“But Zacchaeus stood up and said to the Lord, ‘Look, Lord! Here and now I give half of my possessions to the poor, and if I have cheated anybody out of anything, I will pay back four times the amount.’ ⁹Jesus said to him, ‘Today salvation has come to this house, because this man, too, is a son of Abraham. ¹⁰For the Son of Man came to seek and to save what was lost.’”*
